The Inside-Out Prison Exchange Program is an **educational program**

with an innovative pedagogical approach tailored to effectively facilitate dialogue across difference.

Inside-Out courses bring together students in a traditional higher ed setting (“outside students”) and incarcerated students (“inside students”). More than 150 universities have sponsored courses and over 200 prisons and jails have hosted them.

Inside-Out courses are offered in many disciplines including... African-American Studies, Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Drama, Economics, Education, English, Gender Studies, History, Humanities, Law, Nursing, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Public Health, Religious Studies, Social Work, Sociology, Theater, Writing, and Women’s Studies.

The **Virtual Inside-Out Training Institute** is a comprehensive six-day, 40+ hour intensive training program that covers everything necessary to develop a course in the Inside-Out model. The **Regular Inside-Out Training Institute** is a comprehensive seven-day, 60+ hour program.
